Language requirements

All our programmes are taught in Spanish with a few courses (67,5 credits) in English —2nd, 3rd and 4th year of our bachelor degree—. [📄](#)

All Erasmus applicants* must prove Spanish level B1 at the time of application (B2 if you want to apply for courses from Master's degree).

*Exceptions:

- Italian or Portuguese native speakers. If you have no Spanish language certificate, you must sign and upload [this document](#) with your application. [📄](#)

- Students accepted for project work in English who will not apply for any courses taught in Spanish.

- Students applying only for courses taught in English.

Mentor (buddy) programme

Buddy Programme aims at partnering UPV students with incoming exchange students from the same School.

Through Mentor you can contact with a student of UPV, usually studying at your host school, with the final goal of [helping you](#), specially in the first days.

Your buddy can help you in tasks such as registration documents, search of accommodation, practice Spanish conversation, meet you at the airport, move in Valencia, and many more useful tips for daily life.

To request the support of a mentor student must [indicate so on the application](#). If you have a mentor student assigned you must complete a survey about the experience before leaving.

Project work (BSc/MSc thesis)

Students must find an academic supervisor at UPV by themselves and negotiate the details.

A bachelor / master thesis at UPV is 12 ECTS. Any change in the number of credits must be approved by the UPV academic supervisor and the ETSIE international office.

Students applying only for project work must attach an email of pre-approval from a UPV lecturer with their application documents.

Course restrictions

You may select [maximum](#) 12 ECTS (semester) or 24 ECTS (full academic year) from degrees offered by other Schools or Faculties of UPV, as long as you enroll in 30 or 60 ECTS, respectively. If your total number of credits is below 30 or 60 ECTS, this limit will be reduced accordingly.

Students interested in applying for courses from our master's degrees must be master's level students in their home institution (Italian universities: LMCU is acceptable).

Orientation Sessions

At the beginning of [each semester](#), a general orientation meeting or Welcome Day is organized at the central UPV level for all new exchange students in any study field.

We have held virtual [Welcome Days](#) in previous academic years. Details are sent by email to all students a few days in advance.

Additionally, our School of Building Engineering schedules a [specific orientation session](#) for its own students, with more in-depth instructions.
